

Safety Regulations for Liquids in Hand Baggage

When traveling to or from Europe with us, please adhere to the following guidelines for carrying liquids in your hand luggage.

Allowable Quantities

- Liquids must be in containers with a maximum capacity of 100 ml each.
- The total volume of liquids per passenger should not exceed 1 liter.

Items classified as liquids include:

- Water, beverages
- Perfumes, gels, creams, oils, lotions (including toothpaste)
- Aerosols, foams, and deodorants in pressurized containers

These substances can also be purchased at airport stores after security or during your flight and can be carried in hand luggage.

Special Allowances:

Medicines and baby food needed during the flight can be brought in hand luggage. These should be placed in a transparent bag and presented separately at the security checkpoint. Container Size for Medicines and Baby Food: Package dimensions should not exceed 38 x 24.5 x 11 cm.

Liability for Damages:

We are not liable for any damage or leakage to liquids or fragile items in checked baggage, regardless of whether they are packed in specialized packaging.

For efficient security screening:

- Place all liquids in a transparent bag separate from other hand luggage before placing them on the tray.
- Remove coats or jackets, placing them on the tray.
- Separate laptops and similar electronic devices from their covers and place them on the tray for screening.
- These guidelines ensure a smooth security process and compliance with aviation safety standards.
